TE AROHA COLLEGE BOARD FINANCIAL POLICY PAYMENTS/COSTS/DONATIONS



Rationale

To provide the Board of Trustees, staff, parents and caregivers with a clear understanding of the rights and obligations of all parties in respect to making Payments or Charges

Policies

- 1. The Board, whilst recognizing the right to free enrolment and free education, exercises the responsibility to request payment in accordance with:
- its charter objectives to maximize learning opportunities for every pupil
- the objectives contained in the National Administrative and National Educational Guidelines
- any other regulations of the Ministry of Education
- 2. The Board will provide all requests for payments or costs with clear statements regarding:
- the purpose of the payment or cost
- whether the amount is a voluntary donation or compulsory payment or cost
- whether the payment or cost relates to a compulsory or optional activity
- alternatives to payment or cost
- direct credit facilities
- any other relevant information relating to payment or cost
- 3. The Board will not discriminate against any pupil because of the inability to make a payment and has the discretion to offer financial assistance where deemed necessary in cases of severe hardship.

Procedures

- 1. **School Donation -** The Board will collect Donations annually.
- 2. **Practical Costs -** The Board, through its Learning Areas, will charge <u>reasonable</u> costs for subjects which have a take home component or are an optional extra.
- 3. **Course Related Payments and Expenses -** The Board, through its Learning Areas, will endeavor to specify course related payments and any other expenses such as field trips <u>before</u> pupils opt for that subject. Details will be included in the <u>Subject Guide</u> (this distinguishes between compulsory or optional costs)
- 4. **Sports Costs -** Pupils are required to pay associated costs to a Sports code before competition begins or have made formal contracted arrangements to cover the associated sports charges within the year. If students haven't paid costs for a particular year they cannot play any sport the following year until the outstanding charges are cleared or an approved contract arrangement has been made.
- 5. **Cultural Activity Costs** Pupils are required to pay associated costs before the activity begins, or have made formal contracted arrangements to cover the associated charges within the year. If students haven't paid costs for a particular year they cannot participate in additional events the following year until the outstanding charges are cleared or an approved contract arrangement has been made.
- 6. Exam Costs Exam costs must be paid by the dates set by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority.
- 7. **Visiting Groups -** The Board, through its teaching departments, will notify parents and caregivers early regarding payments for visiting performers where it is an optional extra and not covered under curriculum costs.
- 8. Regular Invoices will detail payments made and requested clearly defining curriculum costs, sports costs and donations.
- 9. The School will <u>regularly advertise</u> to parents and/or caregivers that where difficulties exist in meeting requests for payments, costs or donations the school can be approached in confidence.

The Board of Trustees will review this policy Annually. (Reviewed 2018)

The information supplied is correct at date of publishing, but some items are estimated costs – workbooks, trips, sport tournaments. Te Aroha College reserves the right to alter/update charges where appropriate. Costs are subject to change.

Board of Trustees Review of Couse Costs and Charges

In the last few years the Ministry of Education have made a number of changes to the way schools can charge parents for school activities and course costs. As a result of this we have fully reviewed our school requirements for 2020 with our external financial provider and have reduced and modified our charges as we are mindful that school expenses are often challenging for parents to meet. Te Aroha College is fully subsidising the compulsory components of subjects and courses but need parent support for the additional activities that enrich our student learning. For example, many of the camps and trips have become optional but without parent support for these types of activities we will not be able to continue to provide the same level of enrichment currently offered.

We offer automatic payment options for all parents and strongly encourage parents to take up this option as it helps spread the load throughout the year. Wherever possible we apply for grants and sponsorship to help reduce overall costs and subsidise where hardship may prevent involvement.

School Donation

We remind all parents that although the school donation is voluntary it does provide many of the extra things we are able to do to support the delivery of a quality education for every student and ask that parents make every effort to support us with payment.

Parent Contribution

Where an amount has been charged to support expenses, a Parent Contribution is requested to help cover the costs that are incurred. These are identified in the stationery and course costs year level sheet later in the booklet.

Trips

In some subjects, there may be trips outside of school – eq agriculture or geography. A permission slip will be sent home explaining the trip and any costs involved. If you would like your child to go on this trip, by signing the permission slip, you are agreeing to cover any cost involved in the trip. If the permission slip is not returned, your child will not go on the trip. If your child pulls out of the trip after the permission slip has been signed you may still be liable for full payment.

Payment Options

Payment can be made by cash, cheque or eftpos through the Student Centre, between the hours of 8.30am and 3pm. Automatic payments** can be set up through your bank, or by using internet banking. AP forms are available at the Student centre. You can also use internet banking to make one off bill payments at any time. Our bank details are as follows -

The automatic payment** will be applied to all costs and charges first. Late in the year payment will be put to the voluntary items, eg donation(s) unless we are advised not to do so. **Trips are to be fully paid before departure**. If in Credit, a refund by direct debit can be requested. Be aware however that charges are made throughout the year and the credit balance would be used to cover charges made later in the year.

*** An automatic payment must be of an amount to cover the costs within a school year. We cannot allow families to get into financial difficulty by continually adding camps, trips and sports costs onto their account without a sufficient automatic payment that will allow the account to be cleared by the end of the year. Any outstanding amounts for trips or sports events may be referred for debt collection.

General Stationery requirements

- For items to be purchased from **outside Te Aroha College**, please purchase and have ready for your student to use on the first week of Term.
- All subjects require: Pens, pencils, ruler, glue stick, and scissors. Please ensure your child comes to school every day equipped with the stationery they require.

Course Costs

Course Costs are set as per the College Payments/Course Costs /Donations policy.

- Where a difficulty exists in meeting requests for payments or Course Costs, the school can be approached in confidence. Please email or phone the Principal via the Front Office on 884 8625 extension 810 for an appointment or email admin@tacol.nz
- Invoice/Statements are sent home once a term, but can be requested any time and printed or sent by email. Please contact the Student Centre.
- Course Costs will be charged from the students' timetable. When a student changes subjects,
 Course Cost changes will be adjusted. The subject they are coming out of may have a Course
 Cost change. This may mean that a paid amount (from the previous class) may be refunded.
 The new subject may also have a course cost. The refunded amount will be used to pay the
 new subject and remainder (if there is any) will be put to other course cost or credit balance.
- Art packs are distributed to those students who have paid or have a current AP making payments to their respective account.
- If at any time a copy of a payment receipt is required, it can be printed off or emailed home. Please contact the Student Centre.

Sports Course costs

If students have not paid sports costs for a particular year they cannot play any sport the following year. Please refer to the Te Aroha College Sports Cost Booklet. Any outstanding sports costs will be referred for debt collection.

Personal Learning Device Requirements for 2020

School Supplied Device Year 9 (SSDD)

In 2020 all Year 9 students will be provided with a digital learning device to support their learning programme. These devices will be issued to each student for both school and home use on orientation day. A bond of \$50 is payable for the device to be used at home. Families will be provided with specific information on the usage and expectations around the devices in the New Year.

School Supplied Device - Year 10 & 11

Students at years 10 and 11are expected to bring their chromebook that they were issued at the start of year 9. We remind all parents that a cell phone is not considered an appropriate device. Students require a netbook or tablet capable of running windows and chrome. Advice on device specification is available from Mr Alex Daroux adaroux@tearohacollege.school.nz

Students can download and install Microsoft Office free of charge on their devices at Te Aroha College. A basic internet security package is built into Windows 8, which will be installed on any purchased device. It is recommended that a better anti-virus protection package, Microsoft Security Essentials, is installed. This is available free from the Microsoft website.

Damaged or broken devices

A contract was signed between Te Aroha College, your student and yourself agreeing to take proper care of this device. A bond of \$50 is charged is to cover the first accidental breakage. An accidental breakage is damage caused by an accident – it does not include misuse or willful damage.

All devices issued come with a case – by keeping the device in the case it can help prevent minor damage. The schedule of costs for accidental damages are as follows:

Incident	Charge
First	\$50.00
Second	\$100.00
Third and any subsequent	\$150.00

For any device that we deem as misuse or willful damage you will be charged the full amount to fix the device, or if the device cannot be fixed, you will be charged \$480.00 for a replacement.

We consider willful damage as the following -

- Keys picked off the keyboard
- Graffiti or engraving the device
- Putting stickers on the device
- Hitting or punching the screen causing breakage
- Hitting the keyboard with undue force causing damage
- Improper carrying/storing the device that results in damage
- Damage to the casing of the device that is not caused by everyday use eg cut marks, puncture holes, burns etc

If your child loses or misplaces their device or it is stolen while away from school, you will be charged \$480.00 for a replacement device. It is then up to you to claim it back from your personal insurance.

Should the device's charger be lost or damaged, the school will not cover the cost of this. You will be required to replace the lost or damaged charger at your expense. A replacement charger can be purchased through the Student Centre and as it is a replacement charger it will remain school property

If your child leaves Te Aroha College the device and charger must be returned in good working order before leaving. If there is something wrong with the device you will be charged for any repairs. If the device is not returned when your child leaves you will be charged full replacement costs. Please note – these charges are subject to the school's policy for debt collection.

Please note – these devices have been lent to students at a considerable cost to the school – it is your responsibility as a parent/caregiver to ensure your child treats the device with respect and looks after it.
