Dear Parents Whanau and Caregivers

As of Wednesday 01 September we will be working in the Alert Level 3 of COVID 19 Alert framework and will open Te Aroha College to supervise registered students. We have strong health and safety procedures in place to ensure everybody is kept safe who is on the school site. We would again stress that the safest place for our students and staff is within their already defined family bubbles.

Thank you for all of your continued support of our online learning programmes. We appreciate that this is challenging for many students and we ask for your support to keep checking in with your students on their learning progress. Form teachers will be making contact with you over the next week to update you.

If your family circumstances have changed supervision is available for students who require it from Year 9 and Year 10 if they are under the age of 14 for the week as of 01 September. There will be no onsite provision for students aged 14 years and over. Students at Year 10-13 can not be on site during Alert Level 3 and remain working on their online learning programmes.

This will mean that all parts of the day including supervision, break and lunch will be controlled.

 Students will be required to sign in at the Pavilion and will be given designated entrances and exits in order to ensure social distancing. Please use the Follis Street back entrance for drop offs and pickups.

- Students must wear a face mask
- Uniform is not required

Lunchtimes and break times will be staggered again to ensure that students are able to manage their social distancing.

The school canteen will not be available during the period of Level 3. Consequently all students who are attending for supervision should bring an adequate morning tea, lunch and drink.

Students will not be able to go off site for lunch. The Pavilion kitchen can be used and it includes a fridge, a microwave, oven and sandwich press for student use to prepare or heat food.

If a student is ill or has been in contact with someone who is ill they should not be at school.

If students arrive at school and are visibly unwell parents will be required to collect them.

Absence and communication with the school

If a registered student is absent we require parents / caregivers to make contact with the school.
